

Activities

Astrotourism is a family-friendly activity, with hotspots located at the Darkan Golf Course, as well as Six Mile Cottage.

Betty Brown Museum is open weekdays, and is accessed through the Community Resource Centre. This award-winning museum celebrates women in agriculture.

Collie-Darkan Rail Trail is the second-longest rail trail in Western Australia, and runs for nearly 62km. Why not take a walk, cycle, or even bring your own horse to explore the trail. The trail is suitable for accessible cycles.

Darkan District Sports Club offers a range of sports, including golf, bowls and tennis. It is located to the south of the caravan park. Why not pack your clubs and have a hit on the course?



Activities (Cont..)

Railway Reserve is located in the centre of town, and has a pump track, nature playground, undercover BBQ shelter, trampolines and basketball court. Great for burning off some energy.

Lake Towerrinning is located 33km south of Darkan. It's a great place for swimming, stand-up paddleboarding or waterskiing. It is the home of numerous activities, including an ultramarathon, dragon boat racing, and speedboat state championships.

Located in the east of the Shire, historical **Arthur River** has state-heritage listed buildings. Why not take the time to delve into the past, and explore the walk trail?

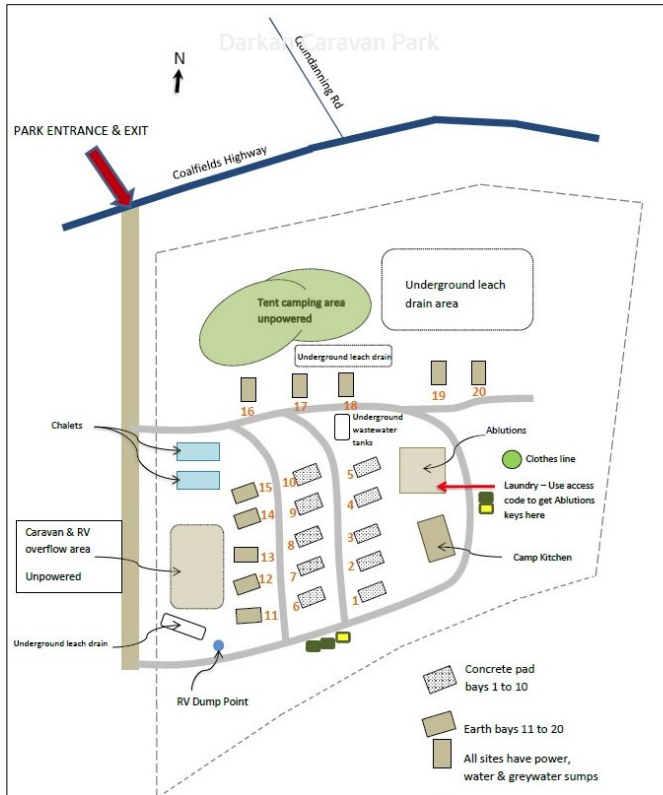


Forest to Wheatbelt

The Park

The Darkan Caravan Park is located within walking distance of the centre of town (1.5km along the Colлие-Darkan Rail Trail). It is a quiet and peaceful place, surrounded by trees and birds. The park is dog-friendly (on a leash).

The park contains 20 powered sites, some with cement slabs, some drive-through, and vary in size from 6 x 4m to 7 x 7m. There are 8 unpowered sites. Once you have booked your site, contact the Shire to receive your allocated site number.



Facilities



Facilities at the park include:

- Fully equipped camp kitchen, with undercover seating and gas BBQ.
- Modern ensuite style ablution block, including disabled access, as well as parenting bathroom with bath.
- Laundry including washing machine and dryer.
- Fire pit area.
- Dump Point.



Chalets and Nissan Hut



Onsite accommodation is available, with two 2-bedroom modern chalets, both sleeping up to 6 people. One has easy access for wheelchairs, as well as an accessible bathroom.

The heritage-listed Nissen Hut is suitable for groups, or travellers with swags. It contains a small kitchenette and living area, and is perfect for those looking for a unique accommodation option.
